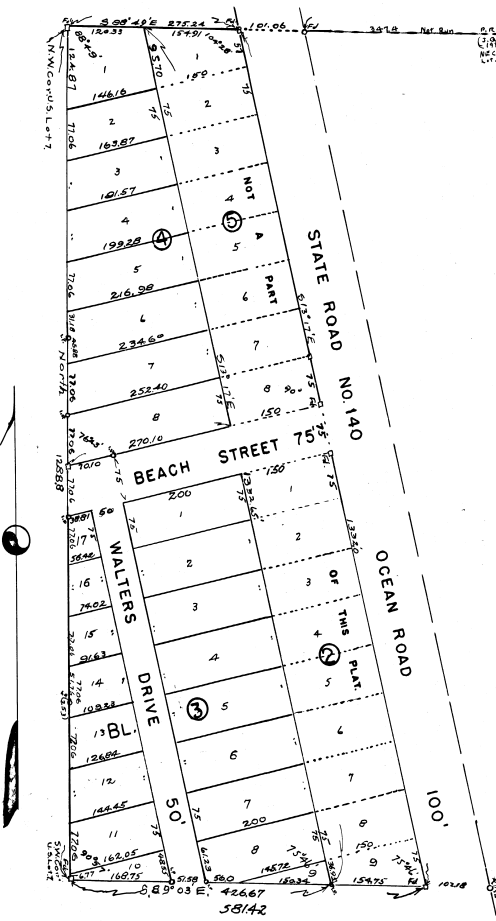
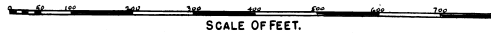

Begin at NW Corner Gov't Lot 7 Sec. 24, T. 27 S., R. 37 E., Brevard Co., Florida; thence South along West side said lot a distance of 1288.8 feet to the Southwest corner said lot 7; thence S 89° 35' SE along South side said lot 7 a distance of 426.67 feet to S.W. corner of Block 3, Ocean Shores Subdivision recorded in Plat Bk. 9, page 6; thence N 13° 17' E along West side of Block 3 a distance of 1392.68 feet to North line Gov't Lot 7, of the NW Corner Block 5, said plat; thence N 88° 24' 59" W along North line Gov't Lot 7, a distance of 1283.9 feet to NW Corner said Gov't Lot 7, the place of beginning.
