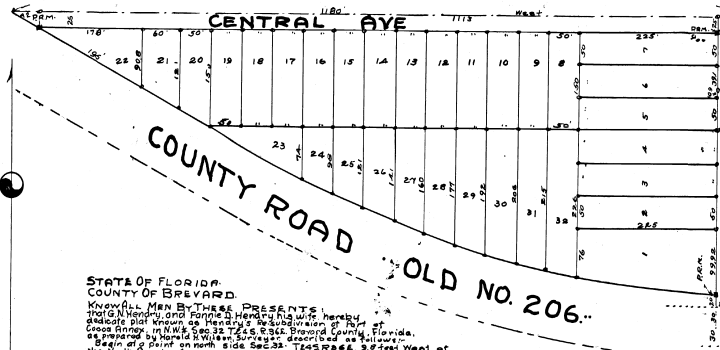


**PLAT OF

Known All Men By These Presents that G. N. Hendry and Fannie D. Hendry his wife, hereby dedicate plat known as Hendry's Resubdivision of Part of Cocoa Annex, in NW 1/4 Sec. 32, Twp. 24S, Rge. 36E, Brevard County, Florida, as herein by Harold H. Wilson, Surveyor, described as follows:

A tract of land on north side Sec. 32, Twp. 24S, Rge. 36E, West of the North Quarter Corner, on line of West side, Pineda Street, produced thereon South on West side, Pineda Street, a distance of 118.25 feet, beginning at the North Quarter Corner, on line of West side, Pineda Street, produced thereon South on West side, Pineda Street, a distance of 118.25 feet, more or less, to the West side of former State Road No. 206, now County Road No. 206, and thence South on West side of said Road No. 206, a distance of 118.25 feet, to the West side of Pineda Street, thence North on West side, Pineda Street, a distance of 118.25 feet to the point of beginning.

An extra 25 foot strip off the east side of tract, and a 25 foot strip off the North side of the tract, for street purposes are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.
